ORDER

NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION

IT IS ORDERED, by the General Post Master Council for The United States of America and the Government of The United States of America to begin issuing a National Identification document in the form of a National Identification card accompanied by a Nationality Certificate, and

TERMS OF ISSUANCE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the National Identification Card shall be issued for the purpose of showing Nationality within The United States of America with the following information attached thereto:

Issuing: Department of State for The United States of America with Universal Jurisdiction

The card also contains the following items:

- Emblem of The United States of America;
- Unique identification number of the card with 12 digit number series
- Photo of cardholder, and

STATUTE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the United States, in Congress assembled write a corresponding statute to guide the General Post Masters in their duty to provide the National Identification Card, and

IDENTIFICATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the identification process is restricted to information that passes the test of responsible party doctrine meaning that that the information provided does have sufficient information to identify someone that may be involved in a crime or other breach of the peace, however, does not violate;

Article 12 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference with his privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to attacks upon his honour and reputation. Everyone has the right to the protection of the law against such interference or attacks,

and upholds:

Article 6 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

Everyone has the right to recognition everywhere as a person before the law.

and

Article 15 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights

- (1) Everyone has the right to a nationality.
- (2) No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his nationality nor denied the right to change his nationality.



RECOGNITION OF RIGHTS

The General Post Master Council for The United States of America and the Government of The United States of America is with the exclusive right to recognize a Nationality claim and sealed with an oath or affirmation granted by the National assembly, and

Further, the Government of The United States of America is with the exclusive right to keep a record of the information provided by the information provider for the purposes of settling a dispute by properly identifying the responsible party. The information provided is required to be without violating the responsible parties privacy with information not relevant to the claim against the responsible party in any court of the Government of The United States of America, and

This order is issued under the following authority:

“Article VI.

§6.1 The committee of the National assembly shall be authorized to execute, in the recess of the United States, in Congress assembled, such of the powers of the United States, in Congress assembled, as the United States, in Congress assembled, by the consent of the National assembly, shall from time to time think expedient to vest them with; provided that no power be delegated to the said committee, over the Government of The United States of America”; in accordance with the Articles of Confederation, as amended August 5th, 2015, and

Therefore this order does not qualify as legislation from the Judicial Branch of the Government of The United States of America, and

IT IS SO ORDERED, by the Chief Judge of the General Post Master Council for The United States of America upon motion of the committee of the National Assembly, and
